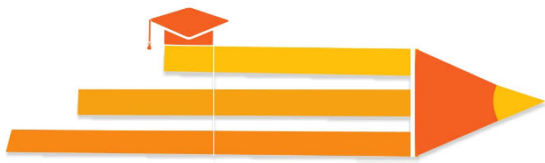

Dr. D. N. Singh, (Ex. Chief Geologist, ONGC) explained the importance of lifelong learning and how the habit of writing enhances the learning process.



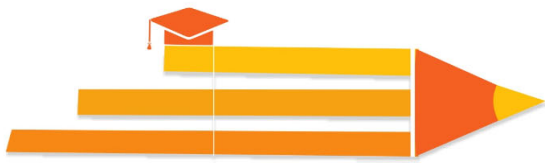

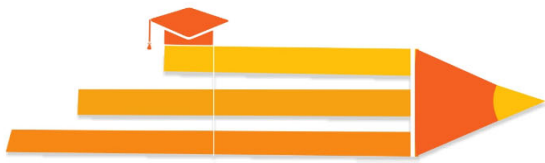

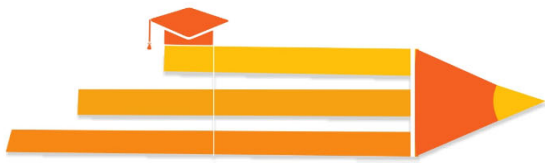
